

Dear Faithful,

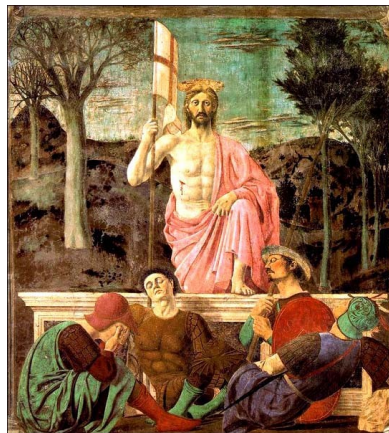
