APPEAL: THE SHRINE OF OUR LADY AT LOURDES. The bishop has circulated a request for an appeal which comes from the Apostolic Delegate for the Shrine of Our Lady in Lourdes, appointed by the Pope as responsible for the Shrine. The Delegate, Bishop Antoine Herouard, has launched an international appeal because, after more than a century, urgent work is needed on the Upper Basilica, the Crypt Chapel and especially on the bell tower and on the spire. The desire is also to up-date the heating and the sound systems, to provide disabled access, etc., in the Upper Basilica.
