**YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH.** Pope Francis, Apostolic Letter "Patris corde" ("With a Father's Heart"), 8th Dec. 2020 - 8th Dec. 2021, recalling the 150th anniversary of the declaration of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church.

**SOME REMINDERS RELATING TO COVID.** If you have been to Church and subsequently contract the coronavirus, please notify me or one of the stewards, so that we may notify the attendees.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and on holidays of obligation does not bind strictly in the pandemic. Those unable to come to Mass should follow Mass on the television or on the radio until they are able to come in person.

Singing is permitted only when wearing a mask. Please continue to wear masks in church, keep social distance, **SANITISE SEATS AND OTHER SURFACES, ETC.** Apparently, sanitising seats and other surfaces has been forgotten by some on Saturdays/ Sunday; it is very important that we continue to take care of one another by cleaning all surfaces touched, so as to reduce the danger of contagion.

**MEACHER ASSISTED DYING BILL:** Write to MPs to oppose this Bill, which would legalise so-called assisted suicide, a form of euthanasia.
