

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL: The review of the pastoral year noted the pleasing, if unexpected visitation of the Bishop, the beautiful celebration of Confirmation (including English Martyrs' feast) and of First Confession and First Holy Communion, and of the feast of the Sacred Heart. People enjoyed both the liturgy and the chance to celebrate together in the hall afterwards. The latter revealed some health and safety matters, which will need to be addressed when the kitchen is altered and the disabled/fire exit ramp are installed. The Talks on the Faith, relation to the pastoral programme in preparation for the dedication of Sacred Heart church and the celebration of the centenary of the church of Our Lady and the English Martyrs in 2025: whether three meetings will be possible next year is not sure, but it is hoped this will be possible, also to encourage those who work to come at an evening time. Looking at one of the texts of Vatican II had been more detailed than may be needed; it was thought we could use the Compendium of the catholic Church, supplemented by extracts from the Council, next year. For the marble ambo for Sacred Heart in relation to the remnant of the will from some years ago, the excellent designs were commended we shall be meeting the marble expert on 13th July as a start to looking at this project. When work, we hope, is undertaken on the tiles of the roof of Sacred Heart church, we shall need to celebrate Mass in the hall for a few weeks. Note was taken of the new Safeguarding handbook which has been issued; some of its demands were seen as very heavy. The next meeting will be on TUESDAY, 4Th October, not Monday 3rd, at 6.30p.m.
