Information at 'pro-life@dioceseof Nottingham.uk'. **MARBLE AMBO SACRED HEART CHURCH:** You saw the design for a possible new, marble Ambo to replace the existing wooden lectern a few weeks ago. Every-one who spoke about the design was very happy with it and there was not a single negative comment. This week we went to see an expert working in marble, who seemed happy with the proposed plan, at least in principle. He will look into the possibilities and will come to visit the church to see the practical realities on a date to be arranged, after which he should be able to make a clear proposal and also give a projection of the costs. If all goes well, then, after the necessary consultations at parish level, it would need to be referred to the diocese for their approval.

CHURCH ROOF AT SACRED HEART: The diocese has been considering our initial request in relation to the replacement of defective tiles (about 30%) and to the replacement of the corroding zinc nails by the more durable copper nails, of the roof of Sacred Heart church. It has been brought before the Diocesan Finance Committee and will need to go to the Diocesan Building and Sites Committee. Then we can expect a reply and will have a clearer idea of where we stand. There is good reason to be optimistic, since the proposed work is essential for the long-term future of the roof and hence of the church. Once we hear anything, we shall up-date you.
