
## All I ask of you, wherever you may be, is for ever to remember me at the altar of the Lord.

MARBLE AMBO SACRED HEART CHURCH: You saw the design for a possible new, marble Ambo to replace the existing wooden lectern a few weeks ago. Everyone who spoke about the design was very happy with it and there was not a single negative comment. The expert working in marble, who seemed happy with the proposed plan, at least in principle, came to visit the church to see the practical realities and was very positive about the idea. He expects to have a proposal, with projected costs, to us by next week. If all goes well, then, after the necessary consultations at parish level, it would need to be referred to the diocese for their approval.

CHURCH ROOF AT SACRED HEART: The diocese has been considering our initial request in relation to the replacement of defective tiles (about 30%) and to the replacement of the corroding zinc nails by the more durable copper nails, of the roof of Sacred Heart church. It has been approved by the Diocesan Finance Committee and by the Diocesan Building and Sites Committee. Insurance details have now been sorted out between the diocese and the firm responsible. We should have a date for the work to begin very soon.

COAST AND WOLDS OPEN CHURCHES: Our church of Our Lady and the English Martyrs' in Spilsby will participate in this event and will be open this weekend on Sat.-Sun., 9th-10th September, 2.00-4.30pm, with Christian art display, ending with Evening Prayer. If possible, try to come along; if you can help with stewarding, please let Stephen Duffy know. Thanks, in anticipation, to those in our parish organising this occasion and being present on those days to ensure its success.

THE HALL: open for teas and coffees after 11.00 a.m. Mass. GIFT AID: This is a way for us to earn extra money on your offerings...it's free money from the government.
