faith, our own personal dedication and our dedication as a

parish, as a living cell of the People of God, to Our Lord. The

Sacred Heart is the core of God's mercy, divine mercy, brought

fully into our world of sin, suffering and death in the very

body of Jesus when He was born for us, revealed as His

unlimited love for the Father in His perfect sacrifice on the

Cross, and at the same time as the unlimited love of God

towards each one of us, as He shed His Blood for us, and as, in

His resurrection, He reconciled us to the Father, forgiving us,

opening to us mortals the gift of eternal life and of unending,

perfect communion of love with the Father, in Him, through

the Holy Spirit. We pray that we may use this Year to grow in

faith, to deepen our prayer, to strengthen our service of God

in His Church, and to be ever more effective witnesses to the

saving, transforming power of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

(martyr = witness to Christ by shedding of blood) in our world.
